



RE: Summer School 2018

The Indiana Department of Education (DOE) has released information regarding the 2018 Summer School Program. All courses offered by the IndVA will be reimbursed at 100% (if supported by the appropriation).

The Indiana Virtual Academy (IndVA) will be offering online summer school courses from June 4 to July 27, 2018. Please refer to our website for a complete list of courses.

The IndVA will also be offering online Physical Education (PE) semester one from May 14 to July 6, 2018, and semester two from July 9 to August 31, 2018. PE is also eligible for DOE reimbursement. Our online PE course is designed to provide students with the basic skills and information needed to begin a personalized exercise program.

Registration for all courses will open on April 9, 2018. For PE courses, registration closes on May 11 (for 1st semester) and July 6 (for second semester). For all other courses, registration closes on June 1st.

Benefits of Participating in the IndVA Summer School Program are:

- No DOE Summer School paperwork for your district to file for students with the IndVA. All DOE reporting is handled by the IndVA.
- No overhead incurred from keeping your building open, aside from proctoring final exams.
- No non-reimbursable administration and support costs.
- No upfront costs. You are not billed until after DOE reimbursement is received.
- The IndVA has pace deadlines that must be met by students. If a student is not on pace by these deadlines the student is dropped from the course and will not be included in the final count for which your corporation is billed.
- The IndVA does not charge your students any fees if your district participates.
- The IndVA uses curriculum that meets Indiana Standards and is taught by licensed Indiana instructors.
- The IndVA is NCAA approved as a non-traditional provider. Please note the credit recovery catalog of courses do not meet these criteria.

For the IndVA to accept your students for summer school at no cost to the student, you will be required to sign and return the attached agreement form. Please note that all final exams will need to be taken in a proctored setting with supervision from your school. We will also need the name/s and email address/es of your high school guidance counselor(s) who will be approving the registrations for the students who register.

Students from your corporation who register for an IndVA course will be accepted if you have agreed to pay the difference per student/per semester course for costs incurred by the IndVA. The cost per student/semester course that was billed to participating corporations for Summer School 2008 was \$32, for Summer School 2009 was \$25. Summer School 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015 were free of charge due to 100% reimbursement from the DOE. The cost per student/semester course that was billed to participating corporations for Summer School 2016 was \$15 and Summer School 2017 was \$21. If the DOE reimburses at 100% for Summer School 2018 there will be no cost to your corporation.

If your corporation does not participate in the summer school reimbursement program, summer school courses are \$190.00 per student/per semester course for our standard course catalog and \$150.00 per student/per semester for our credit recovery catalog.

Please complete and return the agreement as soon as possible as registration opens on April 9. You can do so by mail, fax, or scan and email.
